

# August Judging

We hope everyone weathered the storm OK and we had minimal or no damage to our homes, businesses and of course, our orchids. If you have a small number of orchids, you can move them inside your house for protection. You don't need to water once you move them inside. After the storm passes, move them out and then water and put out snail bait.

If you have many orchids outdoors in a greenhouse or hanging under trees, move them to the ground so they don't blow around and/or get wind damage. Put out snail bait, just in case. Once the storm passes, get them off the ground and rinse any dirt or debris that might be on the orchids or in the pots. If you use fungicides, it might be a good time to apply, and also try to dry them out a little by using fans or anything to facilitate good air movement. Remove any damaged leaves or other parts of the orchid to stop any source of rot or bacterial infection. Unfortunately, this information might be a little late for this storm, but we still have a few months of hurricane season left. We also have some more information in some of our earlier newsletters about dealing with storms. Keep your fingers crossed and hope for no more hurricanes this season.
