February Judging

This evening, seven members brought in all the orchids for judging. Not only will we hope this will continue, but we want more members to to bring in their orchids and participate in our ribbon judging program.

Just remember, when your orchid starts putting out a bloom shoot, don't move the plant or you might get twisted flowers. Now is a good time to spray systemic insecticide like Orthene. The weather is getting warm and dry, so the thrips are getting ready for your buds and flowers!

Stake your spikes to support the weight of the developing flowers. The buds should open and not hang down, but face you, so you see all parts of the flower. Judges like to see clean, healthy foliage. Look at the flowers like the judges do. Look for a pleasant display that is pleasing to the eye.

Owners of judged orchids should look at the judging results and make sure your orchid(s) are listed. Check the names. We take time to question some named orchids to see if the spelling and crosses are correct. We use OrchidWiz as a reference to try and give our members the correct crosses, names, and spelling. Please check your orchids! If you see your orchid name has changed, make a new, updated tag or label and print it CLEARLY and put it in the orchid's pot. It will save you time and aggravation the next time you bring it in for judging.
