April Judging

WE WILL NOT be judging our members' orchids next month. **May** is our **Annual Auction**, so therefore, there will be no judging. We will **resume** judging in **June**.

You should be deep in re-potting your orchids during this time. One of the most important things to remember, no matter what type of potting, mounting, or hanging you do, make sure your orchid is tied securely to your potting medium so it doesn't move. Your orchid needs to attach new roots to the medium as soon as possible and not break its bond, due to a wiggly plant.

We are in need of a few new judges to help judge our orchids. We will train you how we judge and you will learn so much more about orchids. Please step up and offer to help us keep our judging program going.

Lynn Corson brought in a large, clean and well-grown *Maxillaria tenuifolia*, which received a CULTURE Award this month. This species had 74 well-arranged flowers in a hanging pot. Congratuations, **Lynn!**

One last request. When you bring in orchids to be judged and you start to fill out your entry forms, please focus on your penmanship when writing. Some members actually type out their entry forms at home. This is good. Some people fill them out at the meeting, which can be challenging, especially when the judges try to read them. <u>Print out those forms, slow and steady!</u> Thank You.




