June Judging

June is usually the beginning of our rainy season, but this year it started in May. We are also experiencing hotter than usual temperatures.

Now is a good time to get some algicide and fungicide, if you grow your orchids outside, under the weather. Damp, rainy nights can be deadly for your plants, especially if they come for 3 or more nights in a row. For those of you who don't like to use chemicals, an alternative is to run fans at night over your orchids, to help dry them and keep fungus spores from settling on your plants. If you grow your orchids under cover, you still have to be careful and keep an eye out for any fungus. Always water in the morning hours, no later than noon, and make sure your orchids are dry at night. Again, fans are helpful and will also help cool your orchids after you water. Dry plants at night resist fungus and bacterial diseases better than wet ones. Orchids love moving air, so keep those fans running.
